The Department of Pathology, University of Pittsburgh, Division of Anatomic Pathology of University of Pittsburgh Medical Center – Presbyterian Hospital is seeking a pathologist, board certified in Anatomic Pathology, with specialty training and academic interest in Head and Neck and Endocrine Pathology. UPMC – Presbyterian is the major teaching hospital of the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center. It is responsible for 41,000 surgical accessions with a significant H&N and endocrine case load (approximately 5,000 cases) and serves as a local and regional consultation reference laboratory for Western Pennsylvania. In addition to teaching and sign out responsibilities, the candidate would have opportunities for translational projects utilizing the state-of-the-art resources of our molecular pathology, FISH, and other laboratories.

JOB DUTIES:

The candidate would be primarily responsible for sign-out of biopsies and resection specimens along with three other Head and Neck/Endocrine pathologists, on a bench devoted to Head and Neck and Endocrine Pathology as part of our Center of Excellence model. Involvement in clinicopathologic studies, collaborations with clinician scientists and teaching of residents, fellows, and medical students is essential. Participation in other subspecialty sign outs may be possible based on the candidate's interest.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must have an M.D. and Board certified in Anatomic Pathology with specialty training and academic interest in Head and Neck and Endocrine pathology.
- Eligibility for medical licensure in Pennsylvania is required.
- A record of and commitment to scholarly activities and publications
- Must be able to work in the United States
